

Vintage Stunt Championships XIX

March 14 – 17, 2007

Pre Registration Required.

VSC-XIX (19) will be held at Christopher Columbus Park on Silverbell Rd., Tucson, Arizona between Grant and El Camino Del Cerro (See map and Registration form below).

VSC Headquarters Hotel is the Rodeway Inn (520-622-7791) at Grant & I-10. Mention Vintage Stunt when making your reservation. Do not call the 1-800 national reservation phone number.

The Judges Meeting for all VSC judges will take place at the Rodeway Inn on Tuesday March 13th, 2007 from 12 noon to 1PM.

Old Time Stunt (OTS) will be held Wednesday & Thursday, March 14 & 15, one round per day. **Pilots meeting promptly at 7:30AM both days. Official flights start at 8:00AM.**

Classic Stunt will be held Friday & Saturday March 16 & 17; One round per day. **Pilots meeting promptly at 6:45AM both days. Official flights start at 7:15AM.**

Classic Stunt Appearance Judging will be held Thursday (March 15th) starting promptly at **4:30PM at the Rodeway Inn** (See map). As a reminder, **ARF(s)** receive zero (0) appearance points.

Ignition will be held Wednesday and Thursday, March 14 & 15. **Pilots meeting promptly at 8:00AM both days.**

VSC Banquet will be held on Saturday night March 17th at the Marriott Hotel (See map). **Arrive (Bar) at 6:00PM; Seating at 7:15PM, and Dinner served at 7:30PM.**

Attention: Midnight March 7th, 2007. By this date we need to know if you are attending VSC 19. Jim's mailing address is on the Registration form below. Download of Registration Form available at [www.ccmaconline.org]. Three addresses and phone numbers are provided below along with e:mail addresses. Registration can be done in one of two ways. 1) Send in the registration with payment of fees when there is no doubt that it will arrive well before the deadline. 2) Call or e:mail one of the listed people below, when time is short, and mail the form and fees the same day you call or e:mail. Please note that as the deadline of March 7, 2007 get closer there are fewer options available to you. **If we do not know that you plan to attend VSC 19 by either of these two methods by midnight of March 7, 2007, you will have to wait until the following year and enter VSC 20.** The Banquet sign-up is held open by Jim Hoffman until after the start of VSC (the 14th). If you want to attend the banquet and have not signed-up, check with Jim at the flying site by **10AM, Wednesday March 14th**. Our policy is to return your entry fees if you have registered and can not make it; let us know. Refunds for the banquet are handled by Jim Hoffman **and may not be made after 10AM Wednesday March 14th**.

When signing up for the banquet for VSC 19 you will have to choose one of four (2) dinners. You must indicate which dinner you and any other members of you party would like to have. The choices are:

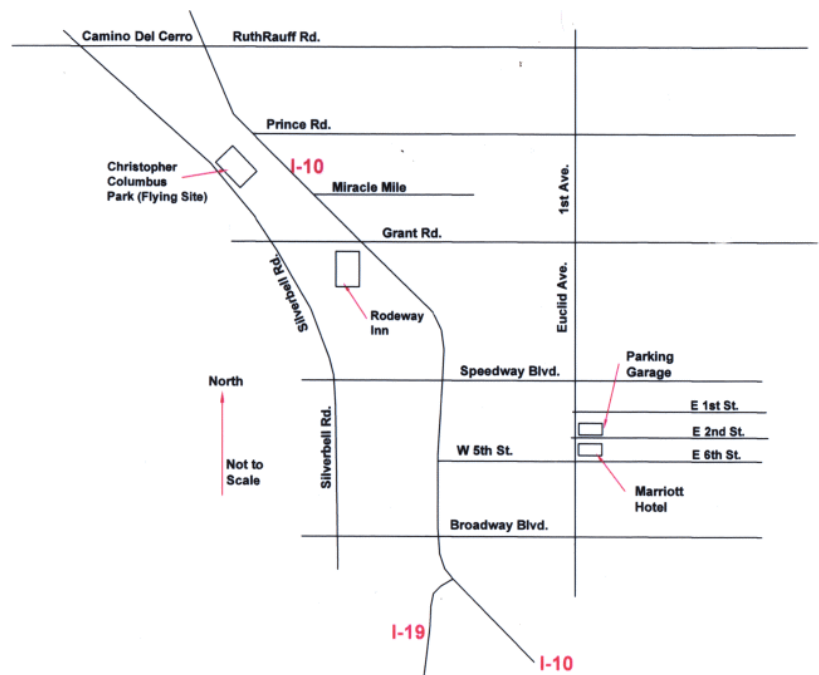

Important Changes:

1) During the two official flight days for Old Time and Old Time Ignition (March 14 & 15), the two unused grass circles will be reserved for Old Time practicing until 11:30AM. No Classic practice flights will be permitted at the contest site before 11:30AM the two days of Old Time competition (Wednesday & Thursday). This step has become necessary due to the large number of Old Time and Old Time Ignition entries running over two days.

2) We expect as large a turn out for Classic Stunt at VSC 19 as that of VSC 18. At VSC 19 Classic Stunt official flights will start no later than 7:15AM both days (Friday & Saturday; March 16 & 17) with the pilots meeting taking place at 6:45AM both days. This is necessary in order to complete each round in a timely manner. Because of the early start the Classic flight order will be posted at the Rodeway Inn during appearance judging Thursday March 15.

The Dinner and Awards Banquet will take place Saturday night March 17th at the Marriott Hotel located at the corner of Euclid and E. 2nd St. The parking garage is on the North side of 2nd St. and the Hotel is on the South side of 2nd St. There will be another party ahead of us which should clear by 6:30PM during Cocktails. Dinner is scheduled for 7:15PM.
